



## Forestry Assistant Position

### Job Description:

New Growth Forest Management is looking for qualified individuals to assist an RPF in a variety of forestry related tasks for the 2024 field season, from approximately April 15<sup>th</sup> through December 1<sup>st</sup>. Project locations range from Eastern Plumas County to Truckee, CA. Applicants must have enough basic forestry knowledge to work independently on a daily basis. *Applicants must supply their own vehicle that is capable of driving on unpaved roads.*

### Potential duties include the following, though additional tasks may arise as needed:

- Treatment area layout including watercourse and roads assessments
- Resource Surveys
- Timber Cruising
- Ability to GPS and download, edit and create maps on ArcMap Pro
- Timber Operations oversight
- Cone Surveys for seed collection
- Assistance during cone harvests including ground crew support and cone transportation as needed (typically August – October).

### The following certifications and knowledge of programs are ideal but not required:

- Cal Fire Archaeological Surveyor Training
- Familiarity with using a GPS and timber cruising tools
- Use of ESRI ArcMap Pro
- Use of Excel
- Familiarity with the California Forest Practice Rules

### Compensation for work includes:

- Hourly rate of \$25-40/hour, DOE.
- The current IRS mileage rate (travel logs are required)
